It is with great pleasure that we extend an invitation to NCER's 5th Annual Scientific Meeting. This year's meeting will be held on February 25th – 27th, 2020 at the Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise, in Lake Louise, AB. NCER enables emergency care researchers to conduct multi-center research or education studies, provides mentorship, creates knowledge through research, supports knowledge translation, and ultimately improves emergency patient care for all Canadians. To date, we've had 31 protocols presented at the annual meetings resulting in collaboration and participation from other sites/physicians in attendance. Two NCER endorsed protocols that have been presented at our annual meeting have received CIHR funding for a total amount of \$1,617,676.

NCER is continuing to grow as a network with increased attendance at the annual meetings. NCER has been hosting an annual scientific meeting since 2016. Over the course of 4 years, the number of attendees has nearly doubled. It is our hope that you would be able to attend this year's meeting and see what all the excitement is all about!
